15. Is it God's Will to Heal Everyone?

- Nabeel says he once believed God's will on the subject of healing is that it is His
 will that some are healed and it is also His will that others are not healed.
 - This view stems from the view that God's sovereignty is the only consideration on the subject.
 - Is this how you see God's will for healing?
 - John 14:9
 - Colossians 1:15, Hebrews 1:3
 - Do you view the will of God and the will of Jesus as two potentially different things? Had you ever considered that because of God's trinitarian nature His will would be the same in all three of there persons of the Godhead?
 - Had you ever considered that Jesus never refused to heal a person who asked for healing?
 - Luke 17:11-19
 - Is it possible that the only reason Jesus healed everyone was simply to show as many as possible His power to heal? Does that fit with your conception of Jesus?
 - Is it possible that God's will towards healing has changed?
 - If it has what would have changed it?
 - Is it possible for God to change His will?
 - Hebrews 13:8
 - Is the question of "Why doesn't God heal everyone" essentially the same as "Why does God let bad things happen to people"?
 - Have you ever considered that the faith of the people around you may have an impact on God's answering prayers for healing?
 - Mark 2:1-12, Luke 5:18-25
 - Mark 9:14-29, Luke 9:37-42
