37. The Power of Prayer, and a Reprieve from Pain

- Have you ever considered how important a birthright is in Ancient Near East culture and how easily Esau traded his away?
 - Is it possible that Esau was more than just very hungry after a single day of hunting?
- Without God's intervention Abraham's line would have Abraham to Ishmael. But God selected Isaac. Then as Nabeel pointed out it should have been Esau but he sold his birthright to Jacob.
 - Have you ever considered that God uses the situation we create to fulfill His will?
 - Do you ever find yourself making Esau's bargain?
 - Have you given up too much in life because you failed to recognize the big picture?
 - Have you ever had an accountability partner that has got in your way and stopped you from doing something you would regret?
 - Did that ever lead to a conflict with or bad feelings towards that person?
- Have you ever heard of Ken Fish or Kingdom Fire Ministries?
 - Do you tend to embrace the idea of healing ministries or is your initial reaction skeptical?
 - 393 of 397 (98.99%) seriously sick cancer patients were healed after being prayed for by Ken Fish. Ken has prayed multiple times for Nabeel yet he still has cancer.
 - How would you explain this?
 - Did Nabeel fail to truly believe when he questioned if he was healed?
 - What do you think about Nabeel's 36 hour reprieve from pain?
 - Are you curious what happened during the prayer time that Nabeel decided not to share?
 - Do you think God would give a person a reprieve as a way to bless them, even if the healing was not going to occur at that time?

- Have you ever envied something someone had even though they had earned it?
 - Do you spend enough time really considering what you have and what others around you do not have?
 - Do you struggle with entitlement or are you grateful for what you have been given?
